## **Program Summary**

The program is research- and experience-based, following recommendations from Exemplary Arizona Principals, the International Successful School Principalship Project (ISSPP), the Wallace Foundation Principal Pipeline Initiative, and the National Association of Elementary School Principals (NAESP). The NAU-ASA mentoring program extends NAU Leadership Preparation and ASA Workshops with critical areas that enhance new principals' opportunities for success, including those recognized in successful principals in Arizona and around the globe (e.g. culture, instructional leadership, culturally responsive and inclusive practices). Mentors will work with mentees monthly via Zoom and will visit schools twice per year.
